General Rules:

This is a scratch tournament open to women members of Yuma USBC. Bowlers will bowl 3 games of qualifying across 3 pairs of lanes. The top 8 bowlers will be ranked 1 thru 8 and put into bracket positions by the qualifying scores. Any ties for the final spot will be determined by a 1 game roll off. The remainder of the tournament is Double Elimination. Each bracket will bowl 2 game matches, (series winner moves on, other bowler moves to the Losers Bracket). Two losses and you're out; Last bowler is the 2018 Queen's Champion. Series total will determine place in final standings. Tournament payout is determined by total entries. Donovan Law has sponsored this Tournament and donated to the prize fund. Final standings will be posted at the Local bowling centers and to <http://yumausbc.org> website.

Dress code during the Queen's Tournament is proper bowling attire. Tournament director has final say on proper bowling attire.

2018 Queen's Champion will be presented with a plaque designating the Donovan Law Queen's Tournament Champion, First Place Prize Money, and an entry into the 2019 Queen's Tournament. Plaque will be presented at the Annual Awards Banquet.

Tournament entries are open until qualifying begins on 17 February. Tournament director has the option of refunding entries and canceling the tournament if there are fewer than twenty-four entrants. Any check in payment of entry fees for the tournament, returned for non-payment, will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00. Payment must be cleared prior to bowling. No checks will be taken the day of the tournament.
