Yuma USBC Baker Doubles Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 1. Divisions and rules for this tournament are stated and included.
- **2.** This tournament is a Baker Doubles Tournament, consisting of 3 games on the same pair of lanes.
- **3.** Teams can consist of women, men, boy or girls. There will be two divisions for this tournament: a. Adult / Adult b. Youth / Youth. Youth bowlers must be under 18 years of age as of 1 Aug 2024, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- **4.** Baker Doubles format to be used: Team members follow each other in order, each bowling a complete frame, until a complete game is bowled. Partner #1 completes a frame. Partner #2 completes a frame; bowler who completed the tenth frame in game 1, will start game 2 and bowler who completes the tenth frame in game 2 will start game 3.
- **5.** The tournament will be run on a handicap basis; handicaps are based 90% of the difference between a teams composite average and 440.
- **6.** Tournament average for handicap will be based on the following in this order:
 - a. Your highest 23/24 USBC average of at least 12 games as posted on bowl.com.
 - b. Your highest 22/23 USBC average of at least 12 games as posted on bowl.com.
 - c. Highest current 24/25 season average of 12 games or more.
 - d. All others will use an average of 220.
- **7.** Average verification is the responsibility of each bowler. Bowlers without verifiable book averages must submit verification prior to bowling in order to receive handicap. If averages are not verified, the bowler will use an average of 220.
- **8.** Average rule: Bowlers will use their highest 23/24 book average or 2022/23 book average (bowl.com). If no book average, their 2024/25 current league average with 12 games, Bowlers with no average, or league sessions without 12 games, will bowl using an average of 220.
- 9. Check-in starts 45 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
- 10. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
- 11. Coaching and refreshments are not allowed in the SETTEE area.
- **12.** Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
- **13.** Foul lights will be in operation.
- 14. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries in each division.
- 15. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART Account #11193 for youth bowlers.
- **16.** Tournament is sanctioned by USBC. All USBC rules apply for this tournament.
- **17.** Tournament Managers decisions are final.
