Yuma USBC Blind Draw Doubles Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Rules for this tournament are stated and included.
2. This tournament is a Blind Draw Doubles Tournament, consisting of 3 games on the same pair of lanes.
3. Teams can consist of women or men; youth will be paired with other youth bowlers.
4. Drawing for team partners will be done by a computer generated drawing.
5. Bowlers paying for the optional 2nd partner, will be paired with a second bowler. Bowlers may be on more than 1 doubles team, even if they only played for one entry. If an odd number of bowlers are on a squad bowled, the computer may pick a bowler at random to be paired together with another bowler.
6. The handicap for this tournament will be based on 90% of the difference between a teams composite average and 420.
7. Tournament average used to determine division placement will be based on the following:
 - a. Your highest 25/26 USBC average of at least 12 games.
 - b. If no current average, then they will use their 2024/25 book average.
 - c. All others will use a scratch average of (210).
8. Average verification is the responsibility of each bowler. Bowlers without verifiable book averages must submit verification prior to bowling in order to receive handicap. If averages are not verified, the bowler will bowl scratch.
9. Average rule: Bowlers will use their 2025/26 average, otherwise 2024/25 book average. If no current or book average of 12 games or more, Bowlers with no average, or league sessions, will use a scratch average of 210.
11. Check-in starts 30 minutes before scheduled bowling time.
12. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area.
13. Coaching and refreshments are not allowed in the SETTEE area.
14. Each game must be bowled on a pair of lanes.
15. Foul lights must be in operation.
16. Awards will be distributed at a ratio of 1 in 5 of the final entries.
17. Scholarship Prizes will be distributed using SMART Account 11193.
18. Tournament is sanctioned by USBC. All USBC rules apply for this tournament.
19. Tournament Managers' decisions are final.
